Holland — College-bound students are invited to attend a public forum on obtaining post-secondary education July 13 at Herrick District Library, 300 S. River Ave.

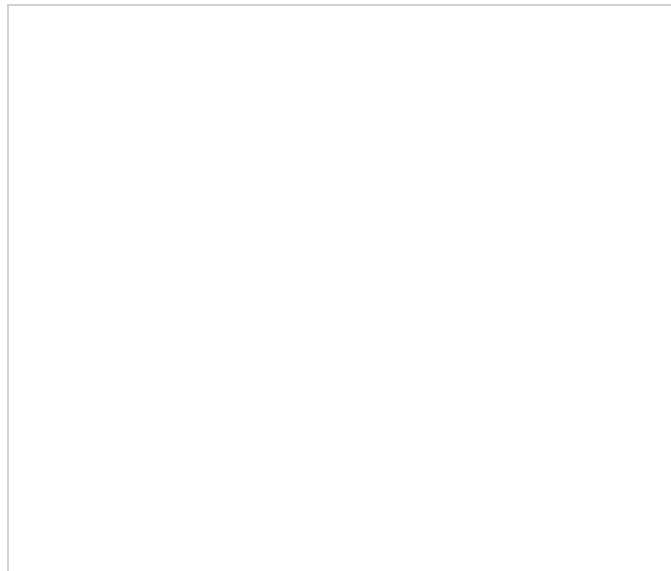
“A Community Forum on Destination Education” will be 6:30-8:45 p.m., with doors opening at 6:15 p.m.
